## Strong, Jewish Home projects move along

A committee of the state Department of Health on Thursday approved two Rochester-area projects.

The Establishment and Project Review Committee of Public Health and Health Planning Council (/story/news/2015/01/26/golisano-hospital-jewish-home-seek-ok-projects/22378109/) gave the go-ahead to Strong Memorial Hospital to add eight beds to the neonatal intensive care unit at Golisano Children's Hospital.

The committee also approved the application by the Jewish Home of Rochester to build 14 home-style residences in the Green House model on its Brighton campus.

Both projects are scheduled to go before the full Public Health and Health Planning Council on Feb. 12.
